INCUBA Science Park A/S was founded on June 1 2007 as a merger between Forskerpark Aarhus (Science Park Aarhus) and IT-Huset Katrinebjerg (the Katrinebjerg IT House). The objective of INCUBA Science Park is to support the innovation and growth of businesses on the basis of a knowledge foundation. We aim at being a supreme home base for innovative businesses; and our most significant instruments are the provision of facilities, networks and sparring as well as the establishment of contact to the knowledge institutions of the region. Dynamism in and between companies is our yardstick.

INCUBA Science Park is committed to encompass various business types and to act partly as an incubator for start-up enterprises together with more established businesses and partly as project hotel housing development departments of major companies. Diversity and commitment are prerequisites of inspiration and growth.

A Short History of The Science Park Initiative in Aarhus

- 1984-85: The idea of a science park in Aarhus is put forward by the Municipality-Business Liaison Committee, and the Association for the Science Park of Aarhus is established
- 1986: The Science Park Aarhus. Ltd. is established
- 1997: Science Park Aarhus at Gustav Wieds Vej next to Universitetsparken is fully developed (11,500 m²)
- 1997: The establishment of the Development Park at 8260 Viby
- 2004: The establishment of Science Park Skejby, a division of Science Park Aarhus, next to Skejby Hospital, part of the University Hospital of Aarhus (3,600 m²)
- 2006: The Development Park moves from Viby to a new domicile at Katrinebjerg and changes its name to IT-Huset Katrinebjerg (10,000 m²)
- 2007: The two companies Science Park Aarhus and The Development Park merge under the name INCUBA Science Park, Ltd. The new company houses 100+ businesses and manages 25,000 m²
- 2008: The enlargement of INCUBA Science Park-Skejby with 2,700 m²
- 2009: The enlargement of INCUBA Science Park-Katrinebjerg with 3,200 m² is due in May
